

Logistics center grows with the company

Geberit extends largest plant in Pfullendorf (DE)

The Geberit Group is expanding its logistics capacity at the Pfullendorf site in southern Germany. An impressive growth in sales coupled with increasing internationalization has made it necessary to extend the warehouse together with the order picking and dispatch areas.

Geberit supplies customers in more than 70 countries from Pfullendorf. The expansion of the logistics services involves continuous optimization in terms of quality and process reliability. In this way, the best possible support can be provided to ensure the company's future growth. Investments totaling around 25 million Euros are earmarked for the project.

The existing logistics center with high-bay racking storage and space for a total of 25,000 pallets began service in 1998. In future, there will be space for a further 23,000 pallets and a logistics area covering 13,000 m². Following conclusion of the planning phase, construction should start in the spring of 2008. The project is scheduled for completion in mid 2009, enabling the extended facilities to commence operations in the fall of 2009.
